

Dear Madam and Dear Governor,

First of all, I hope you are healthy and well. I will try to briefly present the work of our Rotary Club Lukavac for 2019/20. After taking over the position of club president, at the very beginning of this Rotary year, we were dedicated to planning and organizing the Charter Ceremony 10 years of RC Lukavac and 5 years of RAC Lukavac. It was our pleasure to host you at the ceremony, and you yourself participated in the pinning of our new member. So the club has become richer by one member this year, and by the end of my term another potential member has been announced, who unfortunately due to the current circumstances has not been able to attend the meetings.

When it comes to membership, since September 2019, our IAC Lukavac has been extremely enriched with membership (it has about 50 members) and activities that they have started to implement ambitiously. You will be informed about this in more detail through the Interact Club Work Report. We can say that we are extremely satisfied and happy with the work of the Interact Club. Unfortunately, the Rotaract club did not have any significant activities, given that we have a global problem of young generations leaving our city for other cities or countries. We are aware that we need to get more involved in this "problem" with Rotaract membership.

The project we planned to implement this year was the [District Grant "Children's Parks"](#), at meetings there were often discussions about the project and ideas on how to implement it as efficiently as possible. Since we did not start procuring children's devices for parking before March 2020, we redirected the funds approved for this project with the approval of Rotary International to the project related to COVID-19.

In contact with the management of the Health Center in our city (since we do not have a hospital), we asked for information on what the institution needs in the given circumstances, and that it can help in the fight against COVID-19. Already, two isolation wards for sick people were equipped in our city, but with insufficient medical equipment in the form of medical devices. Masks and protective suits, and disinfectants have already been provided by local businessmen as donors, so our club, in accordance with the amount of money at its disposal, procured two [ECG](#) devices, which will be used in the isolation ward, and after the pandemic will be long-term used in the health institution itself as part of regular medical examinations. We procured the devices within 7 days and handed them over to the management of the Health Center, which was also covered by the media, and brought our club an exceptional publication.

In addition to the District Grant project, our club was already preparing to implement, in April, a small project to help our "Little World" center for early autism intervention. It is about the contribution of our members, so that we would make a work action and within the center provide the construction of the necessary (arrangement of partitions-walls) several rooms in which therapies with neurofeedback devices are performed.

Like all of us around and around the world, many plans have been delayed due to the current pandemic. So the realization of our projects awaits some better times. In such new circumstances, we hold meetings via viber. In addition to the dates scheduled for the meeting, I often communicate with the members of our club, because first of all we have become extremely good friends.

It was an honor and a personal pleasure to meet you. Thank you on behalf of all members of the Rotary Club Lukavac and my personal name, for your coming to our club and visiting the Charter ceremony.
