Project description:

Since 2012 RC Sarajevo has established "Rotary Scholarship for Excellence" project, with the purpose of supporting and awarding excellence in education and promoting RI and its mission to the local community. Project starts every new school year and it is implemented in cooperation with 7 High Schools including SOS Kinderdorf in Sarajevo.

Due to an excellent quality of applicants from the last years, this year our goal is to grant scholarships for 20 high school students through trustworthy web application and interviewing procedure, where we expect to have around 60-80 applicants.

Scholarships are awarded to the talented students for their excellence in curricular and extracurricular activities. Each student will receive 100,00 BAM/month on its banking account or the banking account of its parents for 9 consecutive months. The remaining amount will be used on organising and promoting co-founding event "Concert for Excellence".

Sustainability: (How sustainability is granted (e.g. acquired skills, independent continuation, cooperation with local authorities, other partners ...)?

Sustainability is granted through acquired skills gained by student participation in the selection process, which is in most cases their first application and interviewing procedure they are experiencing, as well as possibility for each applicant to become a member of Interact Club Sarajevo.

Additionally, last year a "project in project" has been organized by scholarship students self, with help and oversight from our club members, where students had an interactive learning session with three "role models" from local society. The whole project has been video filmed and presented on "Rotary Concert for Excellence", the club's fundraising project which is one of the ways to raise the money for scholarships.

Every year project is co-funded by organizing "Concert for Excellence", participated by numerous Rotary friends from local community, sponsors and donors and many friends from District 1910 and other districts. The concert, as well as the scholarships programme, have through the years became a Rotary trademark in local community.

This year (2019/20), when RCS marks its anniversary, the scholarships project will be especially important as the event will have a significant media promotion throughout the year, which includes the performances and presentations of students and their projects through various media channels.


